## REGULATIONS

- 1. Only alcohol purchased at Deer Park is permitted on the course.
- 2. Only players are permitted on the golf course - no walkers or caddies are allowed unless authorized by the Pro Shop Staff.
- 3. Each player must have his own set of clubs including bag.
- 4. Cutting in on holes is not permitted at any time.
- 5 Dress code in effect. No muscle. shirts permitted. Shirts must be worn at all times.
- 6. Please be cautious of the grounds crew, beverage cart, and marshal cart while on the course
- 7. Place all litter and recycling in the receptacles provided.
- 8. Persons violating any of the above may lose playing privileges with no refund

## RULES

Golf Canada rules govern all play except where local rules prevail.

· Slow players must wave faster groups through. Slow play will not

- be tolerated.
- · Out-of-bounds defined by the white stakes and fences on holes 4, 7, 13, 15. & 18.
- Red and/or vellow stakes mark penalty areas.
- · Please repair all marks on greens, rake bunkers and replace divots.

## LOCAL RULES

- · Alternative to stroke and distance for lost ball or ball out-of-bounds in effect.
- · The parking lot, cart compound and roadway are deemed to be out-ofbounds.
- · Paved or gravel roadways and paths: drop at the nearest point of relief but no nearer the hole without penalty.
- · Staked or ribboned trees: ball may be dropped with one club length and no nearer the hole without penalty.
- · Screen on holes 1 and 9 are to be treated as immovable obstructions and you are entitled to relief for your swing and stance only - not line of flight or sight.
